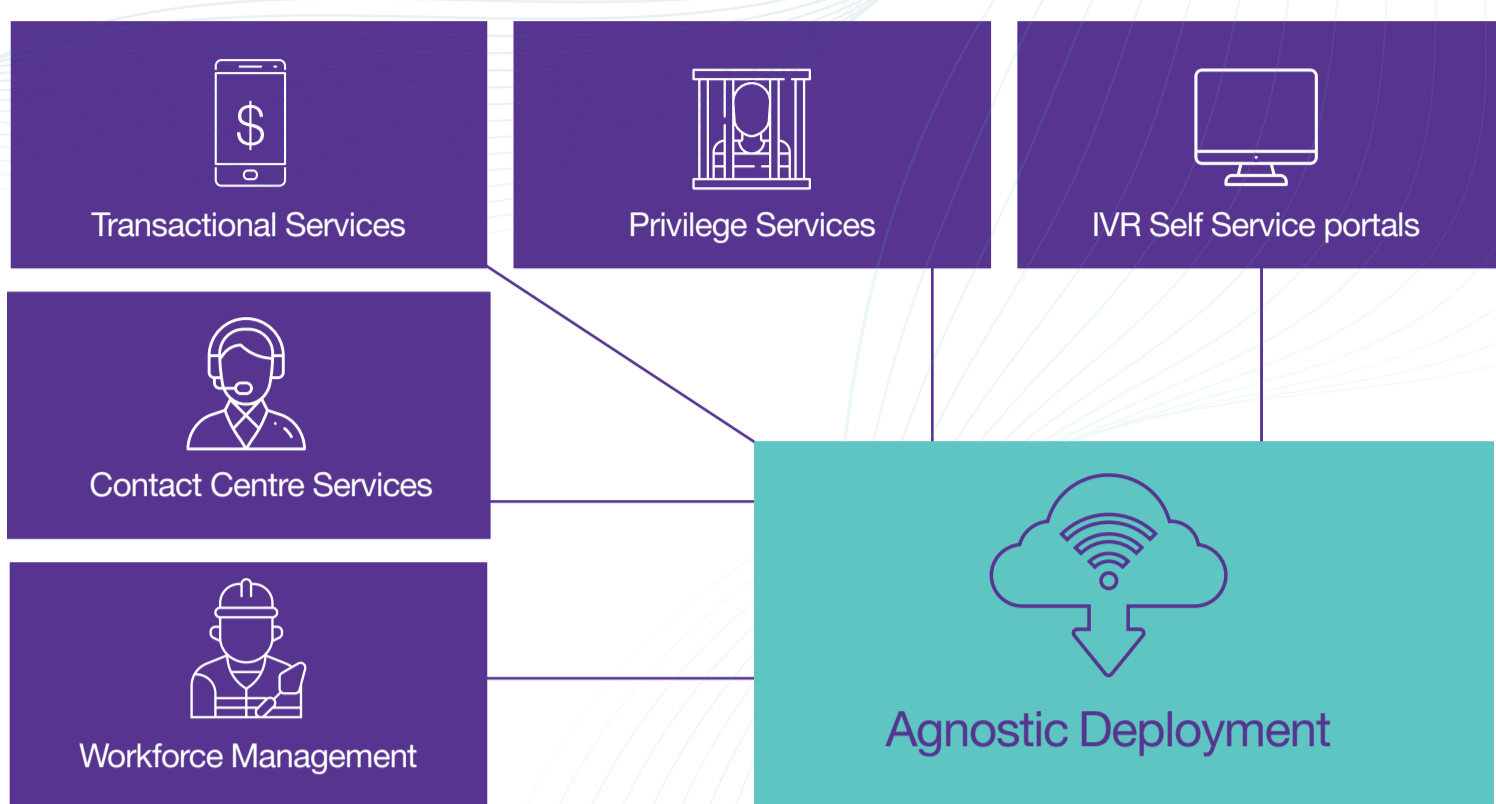

Implementation best practice

Whether you're looking to deploy an "Active" or "Passive" method for your speaker verification there are some key steps to be followed to successfully implement your chosen solution.

Step 1

Voice samples

Establish a method of collecting audio from each person.



Step 2

Enrolment

Gather at least 3 distinct voice samples for accurate analysis.



Step 3

Verification







Set a threshold that balances security and usability
